LOWER CAMP:

First Session: **SUESSICAL**

The overarching plot of the show mirrors that of *Horton Hears a Who*, centering on Horton the elephant's endeavors to protect the people of Who-ville, who live on a tiny speck of dust. It also features characters and scenarios from many other Seuss books. The Cat in the Hat, an outside observer, acts as narrator throughout the show, briefly leaping into the action on several occasions to create conflict and keep the story moving.

Second Session: **PIRATES OF PENZANCE, JR.**

Wacky, irreverent and as entertaining: The Pirates Of Penzance spins an hilarious farce of sentimental pirates, bumbling policemen, dim-witted young lovers, dewy-eyed daughters and an eccentric Major-General, all morally bound to the often-ridiculous dictates of honor and duty.

UPPER CAMP:

First session: **OLIVER!**

...based on the famous Charles Dickens novel *Oliver Twist*. The musical includes several musical standards, including "Food, Glorious Food", "Consider Yourself", "As Long as He Needs Me", "You've Got to Pick a Pocket or Two", "Oom-Pah-Pah" and "Where is Love?"

Second Session: **LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS**

...a 1960's rock, doo-wap, & motown musical about a hapless florist shop worker who raises a plant that feeds on human blood. The musical has several show-stopping numbers including the title song, "Skid Row (Downtown)", "Somewhere That's Green", and "Suddenly, Seymour".

Feel free to get yourself familiar with these shows before camp begins. We'd love to hear and see anyone and everyone who would like to be involved at tryouts. All the information you'll need to know about tryouts and everything else will be announced at mealtime announcements during the opening days of camp, so you'll know exactly where to go, and at what time, to get involved.
