will be attending the Encore/Coda 2010 family camp from August 22 to August 28th.

A \$200.00 deposit for each participant is due with this registration form. The deposit is fully refundable prior to May 1st, non-refundable after May 1st. Remaining fees, less the deposit, are due in full by August 1st as follows:

One program & food fee for each participant:

Age 14 and over - \$350.00

Under age 14 - \$200.00

PLUS

One housing fee for each **group** occupying a cabin:

Cabin w/electricity & external shower house - \$250.00

Half of duplex cabin w/electricity & shared bath - \$450.00

Cabin w/electricity & private bath - \$550.00

Camp Encore/Coda shall provide room & board, linens, and facilities for sports, waterfront, arts & crafts and musical activities. Some activities will be supervised, some not. All waterfront activities will be lifeguarded and are only available when a lifeguard is on duty. Participants are expected to behave well, use appropriate language, and adhere to the instructions of staff members at all times, particularly at the waterfront. There is no smoking inside the camp property.

Participants under the age of 18 are the responsibility of their parent, guardian or appointed childcare provider at all times. Children under the age of 6 must be supervised by a parent, guardian or appointed childcare provider at all times. The camp reserves the right to determine the level of supervision which may be required for participants under age 18.

Camp Encore/Coda is not responsible for the medical care of any participant and there will be no medical personnel on the property. Medical care is the responsibility of the participant. The nearest medical facilities, including hospital emergency room and 911 service, are in Bridgton, 15 minutes from camp.

Camp Encore/Coda is not responsible for the loss of or damage to any family camp participant's personal equipment or effects. Participant and /or parent acknowledges that the camp experience involves risks that are different from home or school experiences and agrees to assume such risks, which may be reduced by obeying camp rules.
